Go North East launches new flexible tickets for part-time workers and those only travelling on occasional days

Go North East, the region's largest bus operator, has launched a new range of tickets to help people who work part-time and those who are working more flexibly.

The company has recognised that some workplaces are still not fully open and social distancing remains in place, so a new range of 'Flexi 5' tickets have been introduced to cater for the more flexible style of working the region is seeing at the moment.

'Flexi 5' allows customers to buy a ticket for the usual price of their weekly ticket but split it over any five individual days. Customers have up to a month to use them from the date of purchase.
